Dates for Registration

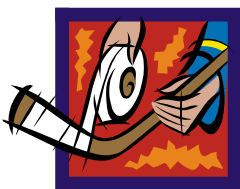


Registration for the 2007-2008 minor hockey season will take place in the lobby of the Summerside Wellness Center on the following dates:

- *- Thursday, Sept 6th from 5:30pm-8:00 pm - (Anyone registering on this night will receive a free ticket to the PEI Rocket game at the Wellness Center on the 6th)
- *- Saturday, September 8th from 10am -1pm
- *- Saturday, September 15th from 10am -1pm

Please note:

- All players must be registered prior to attending any on-ice sessions, which begin October 8th.
- A late fee of \$25 will be charged for any registration received after the last scheduled registration, which is September 15th.

Registration Rates

For the 2007 - 2008 season, registration rates per player will be \$410 for the Novice Division and up, and \$310 per Skills player to a maximum of \$1070 per family.



Registration Payments



In order to register your child, we require 50% of the registration fees paid at the time of registration, with the balance due by post dated cheques no later than November 30th. 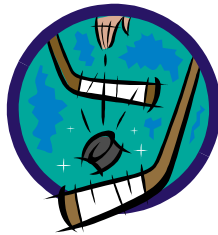


Conditioning Camps

Tryouts

The try-out schedule for this season will be posted on our new website, and will appear in the Journal Pioneer. A fee of \$25 for each level of try-outs is required before participating in on-ice activities. For example, to attend all the AAA try-outs the cost is \$25 per player. If this same player wishes to try out for the AA level, he/she would be required to pay an additional \$25.
